

Postcode type and position

6 alphanumeric characters (ANA NAN) to the right of the province, with a space between the 3rd and 4th characters.

Coding method





Address format

General guidelines:

- The address should preferably be written in capital letters.
- Punctuation should not be used unless it is part of a proper name (e.g. ST. JOHN'S); accents are not regarded as punctuation; the # symbol and the abbreviation No are to be avoided.
- Postal codes must be printed in upper case with the first three characters separated from the last three by one space.
- The municipality name, province or territory code and postcode appear on the same line.
- Only non-proportional fonts should be used.
- Lines should contain no more than 40 characters, including spaces.
- No characters are to be underlined.
- The height of characters should be between 2 mm and 5 mm (10 to 12 points).
- Space between address lines must be at least 0.5 mm but there must be no more than one blank line.
